## Camp Wool— “Welcome Spring” Hook-In

Sat. April 28 and/or Sun. April 29

We are now going to a spring only hook-in format here at Camp Wool. Unfortunately having two a year was just a little too much to get organized! That means this is your one and only chance to get in on our really exciting hook-in! We sure hope you can make it for a very fun and special weekend of hooking. **In addition to eight wonderful vendors offering lots of wonderful wool and goodies here are the other features of our hook-in.**

### Special Features for this 2012 Hook-in Include:

- **RUG SHOW** — Please, please consider bringing a fiber related piece (hooked rug, punchneedle, wool appliqué) for our rug show. Each year we see some fabulous rugs with a public vote for your favorites. Once again we will separate fine from primitive pieces so that voters can better acknowledge your efforts (it’s so hard to choose only one!)
  - **Rug Show Feature Artist** — In addition to the rug show, this year we will also feature primitive rug specialist Tom McNerny. Tom has been hooking for over 40 years and has a unique style all his own. His love of animals and wide cuts are prominent in his work which you will enjoy viewing. Tom can be a little elusive but we hope to have him here both days to answer your questions! Some of Tom’s rugs will also be available as patterns here at Camp Wool during and after the hook-in.

- **AWS RAFFLE** — *100% of the proceeds going to the local Animal Welfare Society shelter! **Calling for donations from attendees!!! Please read on..... Rather than a silent auction this year we thought we’d mix it up a bit! Instead we are calling for donations that are fiber related that we can put into a raffle. Maybe you could knit a pair of warm wool socks, or hook a small mat with an animal theme, create a punchneedle or wool appliqué piece, or maybe a care package for us humans, anything hand made and/or new (unused) (animal theme preferred but not necessary) will be accepted.***

- **Raffle Donation Items**—*Anyone bringing in a donation (can be brought to the store prior to event or brought to the hook-in) will automatically be entered into a drawing for a \$50 gift certificate to the store.*

**Raffle—How it will work:** *After all items have been checked in (roughly 10:00) we will make raffle tickets available for purchase. Individual tickets will be \$1.00 or 6 tickets for \$5.00. You can place your tickets in multiple items or just one to improve your odds. During the event we will announce a cut off time and announce the winners!!*

- **AWS FOOD OR CASH DONATION** — *So many of you have adopted and realize how much joy an animal can bring to your life. Even if you have not adopted, chances are you know someone that has and the joy it has brought to their lives. Not able to participate in the raffle?? Well perhaps you might consider bringing a food or other donation item to the event (see list below provided by our local shelter). Participation is completely elective! *All participants including vendors that submit an item or bring in a donation to the hook-in will be registered to win a \$30 gift certificate to Camp Wool. **Accepted Donations Include:** Unopened dry dog/puppy and cat/kitten food; or unopened canned food; cat litter, unopened small animal food, fresh vegetables for small animals, Clean, gently used blankets, Clean, gently used towels, unused dog, cat and bird toys, peanut butter, gift cards to Wal-Mart, Target, PetSmart, PetQuarters, Kennel Shop, paper towels, Laundry detergent, bleach. **Directions:** via Maine Turpike (South or North) take exit 19 (Wells Exit). At the stop light (Rte 109) take a left. Stay on 109 until you get to Route 1. Take a left on Route 1 (heading north) and go approx. 1.7 miles to the Coastal House which is on the left side (West) of Route 1.

**Please Bring a finished piece for our Show:** Please bring a favorite project you have made from the past (no time restrictions). Anything made from wool can be accepted including hooked rugs, penny rugs or punchneedle!!!

**Registration Details: Spots may be reserved by coming in person to the store on or after Mon. Jan. 16 OR by mailing a check with your completed registration form to the address below OR calling Camp Wool and paying by Credit card.**

- ⇒ All spots will be reserved on a first come basis. Mailed registrations will be prioritized based on post marked date not receipt date. This will help to keep the process equal regardless of where you live or speed of the mail!
- ⇒ If you are coming with a group, we highly recommend you collaborate in advance on the day you wish to attend. We will do everything possible to accommodate groups.
- ⇒ An individual can sign up as many attendees as they want (by mail or in person).
- ⇒ **Cancellations Refunds—1/2 of fee will be refunded up to March 15.** Due to incurred costs we cannot refund after that date. We request that anyone that cannot attend please call prior to the event so that another individual can attend should we have a wait list. Anyone on the wait list will be notified via phone and their check returned should they not get in.
- ⇒ Switching days or giving spots to others without consulting Camp Wool is not permitted. **We will do our best to accommodate changes!**
- ⇒ Due to site capacity constraints and overall security, we cannot accommodate vendor only attendees. Non-paying guests are not permitted. Drop offs and pick ups are just fine. This is a secure event. No food may be brought into the premises unless prior approval is received (Coastal House restriction).
- ⇒ All reservations will be confirmed by PHONE within 1 to 2 weeks of registration. I will be calling each individual registered to confirm. **Your cancelled check is also evidence of your attendance to the event.**
- ⇒ **Due to the high cost of producing and mailing forms should you require additional forms be mailed an additional charge of \$1.00 per mailing will be charged. 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# Camp Wool—New Floor Frames—Now Available

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I will now be carrying a new floor frame that is made right here in Kennebunk, ME by a wonderful carpenter who guarantees the construction! I have my experiences with using different frames to put in features that I think you will appreciate including: All hardwood maple construction, wider wood base for stability when working on larger rugs, metal and solid hard fiber ball joint (no squeeking) for 360 degree turning, all dowel pinned joinery (joints are guaranteed not to come unglued) and deeper base to face frame clearance makes it easier to reach under to hook. We will also soon be offering a range of colors for custom staining if you would like! Price is \$260.00 - Frame opening is 14" x 16' (custom staining will be an additional charge).

### Primitive Rug Hooking Class (1-2 people per class)

I will help you or you and a friend get started (or restarted) into the world of rug hooking. This format allows us to move at a good pace and cover all the basics of rug hooking. At the end of the session you will be able to hook using basic skills and techniques that will allow you to finish your projects and beyond! Free follow-up visits to help you

### finish your rug including instruction on binding off your rug!!

**What you need:** You will be able to pick from a large group of small projects (wool & linen backing included) that I have here at the shop.

In this class you will learn the basics of rug braiding. You will get to choose your color schemes prior to the class. All the wool and braiding lacing thread will be provided as well as T-pins, safety pins and clamps. You will get close to finishing your project the day of class. Prior to leaving you will be taught how to finish off your piece.

**What you need for this class:** You will need to bring scissors and braid-aids if you have them (they can also

be purchased here at the store the day of class—\$17.50). Note: The use of braid-aids is optional.

**Cost of Class:** Instruction plus the wool for the project is \$70.00. (Braid-Aids extra). Lunch and beverages are also included.
